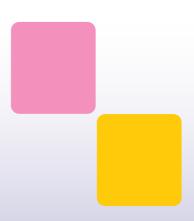

Stretch Marks: The Facts



Stretch Marks are very common... and a big problem

Anyone can get Stretch Marks, but they occur more often in women than men.

In fact...

- 70% of all women and 40% of men will suffer Stretch Marks some time in their life. (1.)
- More worryingly, 90% of all pregnant women get Stretch Marks.
- It is a big issue and it causes distress and upset to many people who suffer from it.



Causes of Stretch Marks

The are several factors that can either cause Stretch Marks or make developing them more likely, these are:

Pregnancy

Pregnancy is a big factor in Stretch Mark development, particularly after the sixth month of pregnancy. Hormones that are produced by the body to help soften ligaments ready for birth also soften fibres in the skin increasing the risk of developing Stretch Marks.





Gaining Weight Quickly

Stretch Marks are more likely to occur if a lot of weight is gained during a short period of time. Regular dieting and then subsequent rapid weight gain is the main cause of Stretch Marks.

Puberty

Young people tend to grow very fast during puberty which puts extra strain on the dermis. Males often get Stretch Marks on their shoulders and back, whereas females tend to get them on their hips, thighs and breasts.



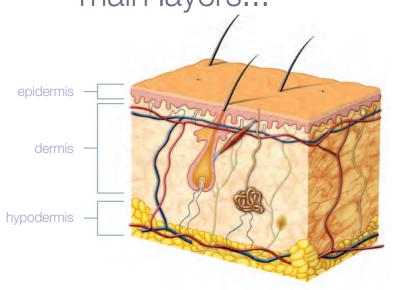


Family History

If you have close relatives who have Stretch Marks (such as your mother) the risk may be greater.

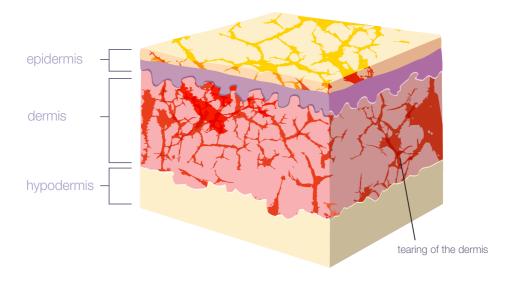
The Science Behind Stretch Marks

Our skin is made up of **3** main layers...



- The Epidermis is the outer layer of the skin that forms a protective barrier.
- The Dermis is the strong, supportive middle layer of the skin that gives the skin its strength and elasticity
- The Hypodermis is the inner layer of the skin, consisting of fat and supportive connective tissue

How do Stretch Marks Develop?



- Stretch Marks occur in the dermis when the skin is stretched considerably over a short period of time, e.g. puberty, pregnancy, rapid weight gain.
- This rapid skin stretching causes the dermis to tear in places to relieve the pressure.
- As the dermis tissue starts to repair itself it lacks the smooth regular appearance of normal skin hence the raised appearance of Stretch Marks.
- Ultimately, Stretch Marks are scars and should be treated in the same way.

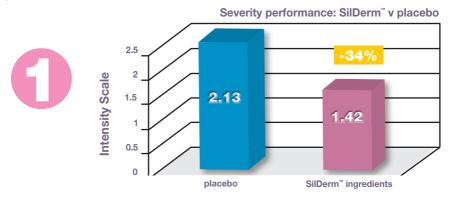

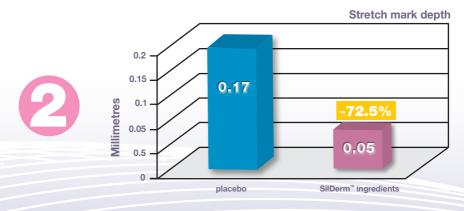

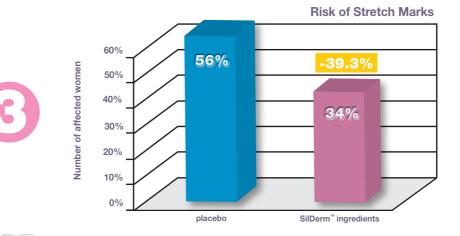
